TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE REPRODUCTION OF INFORMATION FROM THE HISTORIC ENGLAND ARCHIVE

1. Agreement

- 1.1 The Historic England Archive is part of the Historic Buildings and Monuments Commission for England (“**Historic England**”).
- 1.2 Subject to clause 1.3 (below) Historic England permits the person, organisation or company named overleaf (“**You**”) on a non-exclusive and non-transferable basis to reproduce, make available or otherwise use the images or other items listed overleaf (“**the Information**”) in the territory named overleaf (“**the Territory**”) for the purposes listed overleaf (“**the Use**”).
- 1.3 The permission granted pursuant to this clause 1 is not valid until any due payment is received (see clause 8 below), **and** You have returned a signed copy of this agreement, without alteration, to Archive Services at the address given overleaf.
- 1.4 The details set out overleaf are expressly incorporated in these terms and conditions.
- 1.5 Unless otherwise stated, permission extends to one edition of a printed work in volume, or the single use of the Information, as the context requires. All other rights are hereby reserved absolutely.

2. Duration

- 2.1 The duration is as stated overleaf and the commencement date shall be the date of issue (overleaf), subject to clause 1.3.
- 2.2 You will have to make a new application for any reproduction, exploitation or use, other than as specified in this document.

3. Digital Reproduction
